Antinuclear antibody (ANA) test (an-tee- NOO-klee-ar/ AN-tee-bod-ee)	Blood test to assist in diagnosis of autoimmune diseases
HIV antigen/ antibody immunoassay (im-yoo-noh-ASS-ay)	Blood test for HIV infection; tests for both HIV antigens and antibodies
Western blot	Test used as a backup to the ELISA blood test to detect the presence of the antibody to HIV in the blood
Diagnostic Imaging	
Lymphangiogram (lim-FAN-jee-oh-gram)	X-ray record of the lymphatic vessels produced by lymphangiography
Lymphangiography (lim-FAN-jee-oh-graf-ee)	X-ray taken of the lymph vessels after the injection of dye into the foot. The lymph flow through the chest is traced
Monospot	Blood test for infectious mononucleosis
Scratch test	Form of allergy testing in which the body is exposed to an antigen through a light scratch on the skin
Magnetic Resonance imaging (MRI) (REZ- oh-nens)	Use of electromagnetic energy to produce image of soft tissues in any plane of the body.
