Bony Processes	Definition
Head	A large, smooth, ball-shaped end of a long bone that may be separated from the body is shaft of the bone by an area called the neck.
Condyle	Smooth, rounded portion at the end of a bone
Epicondyle	Projection located above or on a condyle
Trochanter	Large rough process for the attachment of a muscle
Tubercle	A small rough process that provides the attachment for tendons and muscles
Tuberosity	Large, rough process that provides the attachment for tendons and muscles
Sinus	A hollow cavity within a bone
Foramen	A smooth round opening for nerves and blood vessels
Fossa	A shallow cavity or depression on the surface of a bone
Fissure	A slit-type opening
