<p><b>INTRODUCTION</b> Tells what the essay is about and captures readers' attention</p>	<p><i>Capture the readers' attention:</i></p> <p><i>Clearly state the topic of the essay:</i></p> <p>Child labor...</p>
<p><b>BODY PARAGRAH 1</b> Develops the topic with facts and details</p>	<p><i>Main idea:</i> child labor in the U.S. during the Industrial Revolution</p> <p><i>Facts, definitions, details, and examples to develop your main idea (should come from the sources):</i></p>
<p><b>BODY PARAGRAH 2</b> Develops the topic with facts and details</p>	<p><i>Main idea:</i> child labor on cocoa farms</p> <p><i>Facts, definitions, details, and examples to develop your main idea (should come from the sources):</i></p>
<p><b>CONCLUSION</b> Sums up what the writer wants readers to know</p>	<p><i>Draw a conclusion:</i></p> <p><i>Final thought:</i></p>
