SCRABBLE™ Sight Word Instructions

- TEACHER: Collect some Scrabble™ tiles. I buy games at garage sales. Check your basement. I also put out the little wooden trays but they are not necessary. Print up copies of the Scrabble™ Sight Word sheet. I like to provide a sheet of our sight words for the kids to use. But they tend to like to think of their own and use the word wall or their writing folder list. Make sure you have enough tiles for lots of sight words.
- of STUDENTS: Pour out the tiles and turn the tiles face UP so the letters show (put name on paper). Choose a word to build. Build it on the tray or on the top of the worksheet. Write the word using lowercase letters in the column marked **Write It**. Now add up the numbers on the tiles. Depending on the math levels: make a math sentence and add (3 + 1 + 1 = 5); or have the students tally for each number $(\frac{1}{1})$. See if you can make the words with the most points.
